LNG Shipping and Cargo Handling (LNG-II)

Course Overview

This programme is aimed at everyone involved in the LNG supply chain. The course covers training on health and safety, communication, LNG procedures, equipment used in the process, emergency response as well as optional units for either onshore or offshore working practices and procedures.

Who should attend?

This programme is appropriate for:

- Mid-level LNG project managers, senior LNG project managers, and senior technical specialists
- LNG Shipping staff and crew
- New hires in an LNG plant who need to become familiar with this aspect of the LNG industry
- Anyone who wants a basic understanding of the procedures for loading and unloading LNG carriers, staffing requirements and responsibilities, and regulations for safe, secure operation

Topics covered

- The LNG market and its positioning in the global energy sector
- The characteristics and hazards of working with LNG and LNG transfer
- LNG transfer-ship to ship, ship to shore, shore to ship and bunkering
- The emergency response requirements and procedural requirements within the process of bunkering/lightening
- LNG plant, equipment, processes and the people interface
- Situational awareness techniques and decision making capabilities based on facts and data
- Safe working processes and procedures
