## Emergency Centred Leadership (ECL)

### Course Overview

A critical event can be extremely challenging, often involving high stakes and high consequences. To successfully navigate through these adverse times, leaders need to rely on the application of specific pressure-related skills and qualities.

Mastering the application of these skills will enhance personal and organisational resilience.

This course has been specifically developed by highly experienced industry experts to equip learners with the practical tools to operate efficiently and effectively when everything is at stake.
